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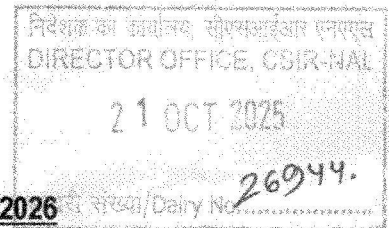

To meet above expenses, we can expect the following **income**:

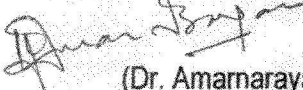
1. CPWA grant	Rs.2.0 Lakhs
