The following four members have agreed to join the Managing committee of NAL PWA.



NAL PWA and CSIR – NAL jointly hosted the Dr. Sita Ram Rao Valluri Centenary celebrations which was held on 25th June 2024 inside NAL Campus.



Dr. Sitram Rao Valluri Celebrations were held at the Dr.S.R. Valluri Auditorium of CSIR-NAL on 25th June 2024. Dr. Valluri was the second Director of CSIR-NAL and held this post for Nineteen years from 1965 to 1984.

Dr. Valluri was born on 25th June 1924 in Eluru in Andhra Pradesh. He obtained his B.E. degree from Banaras Hindu University, obtained his Post Graduation in Aeronautics from IISc, Bangalore. He continued his higher studies in Aeronautics at CALTECH in USA after obtaining the Pauley Scholarship. He established himself as an Aircraft Fatigue and Fracture expert for which he was awarded the Wright Brothers Medal in 1963. He briefly worked as a design consultant with Douglas Aircraft Company in USA. He then returned to India and joined IIT Madras as Senior Professor. The then Director of NAL Prof. Neelkantan

suddenly passed away on 18th April 1964. Dr. S.R. Valluri then took over as Director of NAL on 23 Nov 1965.

Dr. Valluri first task in NAL was the completion of the 4 ft tunnel which was initiated by Prof. Neelkantan, this task was completed by Dr. Valluri and the tunnel became operational with the first blow down on 29th May 1967.

Other highlights of Dr. Valluri's contributions during his tenure NAL were:

- a) Creation of the Materials and Structural Sciences Division.
- b) The Materials Division achieved heights with the establishment of a Full Aircraft Testing Rig fabricated for Gnat and Mig Aircrafts of the Indian Air Force.
- c) The Structures Division helped the ISRO in Aeroelastic Testing of PSLV, ASLV and all other launch vehicles. Structural testing of India's first Satellite Arya Bhatta was also done in this division.
- d) India's first Acousting Testing facility (ATF) for all Satellites of ISRO was tested at this facility which was established near the compressor air facility in the NWTC campus.
- e) Dr. Valluri introduced the Project Accounting System to track and monitoring the funds spent on each of the several projects of NAL. This was a unique method of managing the various projects of NAL in the various divisions of the laboratory.
- f) Establishment of the Electronics and Instrumentation Division which in later years pioneered in Flight Simulation and establishment of the Flight Control Laws which was ultimately used on the Tejas Aircraft. The "Black Boxes" which used to investigate Aircraft crashes which was often sent abroad for analysis is now done in this division thanks to the writing of the suitable software for decoding the "Black Boxes".
- g) Establishment of the Advance Composite Division. Today all of us should be proud that the Tejas fighter Wings, Fuselage and the Vertical Stabiliser made out of Carbon Fibre Composites are fully fabricated are regularly supplied to HAL for this Fighter Aircarft.
- h) Vast improvement in Infra structure of NAL, like an excellent Health Centre well equipped with good facility like X Ray, ECG, Blood, Urine testing facility along with a good group of five Doctors along with support staff like nurses and Pharmacists and Lab technicians.
 - Dr. Valluri's achievements were lauded by the then DG CSIR Dr.Hussain Zaheer and Late Shri J R D Tata who was the Chairman of NAL Executive Committee. Dr. S R Valluri was awarded "Padma Vibhushan" for his achievements.


After Dr. Valluri retired from NAL in 1984, he went to head the Aeronautical Agency (ADA) as Director General which pioneered the design and fabrication of India's Indigenous Fighter Aircraft "Tejas" which is flying proudly today.

The Centenary Celebrations started with the Inauguration of Dr.S R Valluri's bust just outside the Valluri Auditorium, was done by the NAL Director Dr. Abhay Pashilkar in the presence of many dignitaries.

Dr.Raghu Prakash was a scientist in NAL before he moved our ti IIT, Madras. This was followed by many dignitaries who had worked with Dr.Valluri in their yesteryears. Speakers included Dr.K.S.Yajnik, former Head, CMMACS, Dr.R M V G K Rao former Head FRP Division,NAL, Dr. Srinivas Bhogle, former Head KTMD, Dr.Nanjundaswamy, Chief Medical Officer (Retd.) NAL and many other dignitaries. This was followed by a tree planting ceremony in the campus. We must recall that Dr. Valluri was a nature lover and many of the Large trees were planted and nurured by him.




